GENERAL ORDER NO. 106

Any copy of a presentence report which the court makes avail-
able or has made available, to the United States Parole Commission
or the Bureau of Prisons constitutes a confidential court document
and shall be presumed to remain under the continuing control of the
court during the time it is in the temporary custody of these
agencies. Such copy shall be lent to the Parole Commission and the
Bureau of Prisons only for the purpose of enabling those agencies
to carry out their official functions, including parole release and
supervision, and shall be returned to the court after such use, or
upon request. Disclosure of a report is authorized only so far as
necessary to comply with 18 U.S.C. § 4208(b)(2).
