Although reports are placed on loan to the attorney of record, these reports are not to be duplicated, in total or in any part, or disclosed to or discussed with anyone other than the defendant, co-counsel, the investigator, if any, or with the appropriate Assistant U. S. Attorney. Bail reports are to be returned to the probation officer in court immediately following a bail hearing.
