GENERAL ORDER NO. 163

Good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that General Order No. 161 entitled
"Reference of Bankruptcy Cases After July 10, 1984" is hereby
amended to read as follows:

(1) Referral of bankruptcy cases and proceedings.
Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §157(a), the court hereby
refers to the bankruptcy judges for this district
all cases under title 11 and all proceedings under
title 11 or arising in or related to a case under
title 11.

(2) Bankruptcy appeals. (a) Pursuant to 28 U.S.C.
§158(b)(2), the court hereby authorizes a bankruptcy
appellate panel to hear and determine, upon the con-
sent of all the parties:

(i) appeals from final judgments, orders,
and decrees entered by bankruptcy judges
from this district; and

(ii) with leave of the panel, appeals
from interlocutory judgments, orders,
and decrees entered by bankruptcy judges
from this district.

(b) The appeals the bankruptcy appellate panel
may hear and determine under subparagraph (a)
include:

(i) appeals pending in the district
court on the effective date of the
Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal
Judgeship Act of 1984 (The Act);

(ii) appeals filed after the effective
date of the Act; and


(iii) appeals transferred from the
bankruptcy appellate panel to the
district court pursuant to section 115(b)
of the Act.

(3) Withdrawal of emergency bankruptcy rules and procedures. The emergency rules and procedures adopted by this district following entry of the Supreme Court's judgment in Northern Pipeline Construction Co. v. Marathon Pipe Line Co., 458 U.S. 50 (1982), are hereby withdrawn.
