WHEREAS, By Public Law 89-372, 89th Congress, S. 1666, March 18, 1966, the Congress of the United States created the Eastern District of California out of the previously existing Northern Division of the Southern District of California and a portion of the Northern Division of the Northern District of California;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that until further order of this Court all cases and legal proceedings of every nature and kind cognizable by the United States District Court arising in Fresno, Kern, Tulare, Kings, Inyo, Mariposa, Madera and Merced Counties, together with all cases and legal proceedings of every nature and kind cognizable by the United States District Court arising in Yosemite National Park, shall be commenced in the United States District Court sitting in Fresno, California. All other cases and legal proceedings of every nature and kind cognizable in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California shall be commenced in Sacramento, California
