ORDER FOR ADMISSION OF ATTORNEYS
TO PRACTICE IN EASTERN DISTRICT

GENERAL ORDER NO. 19

WHEREAS, By Public Law 89-372, 89th Congress, S.1666, March 18, 1966, the Congress of the United States created the Eastern District of California out of the previously existing Northern Division of the Southern District of California and a portion of the Northern Division of the Northern District of California;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all attorneys now admitted to practice before the highest Court of the State of California be granted the privilege of practicing before this Court up to and including the 31st day of March, 1967. Thereafter, all attorneys desiring to practice before this Court, not specially exempted by law or the Court, shall qualify and be admitted to practice before this Court in accordance with and subject to the conditions of Rule 1 of the Rules of Practice of this Court;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that members of the Bar of the Northern District of California and the former Southern District of California shall, up to and including March 31, 1967, be authorized to execute the certificate and make the motion required by the aforementioned Rule 1 of the Rules of Practice of this Court;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the fee for admission to practice before this Court be fixed at the sum of \$7.00 until the further order of this Court.


