
GENERAL ORDER NO. 200

The probation office of this Court shall commence a background investigation at the time of arraignment of all defendants charged with Unlawful Entry or Unlawful Presence in the United States, providing the defendant and his counsel have consented in writing to the investigation. The report of this investigation shall not be submitted to the Court or its contents disclosed to anyone unless the defendant has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere or has been found guilty, unless the Court, with consent of the defendant, directs otherwise.
