Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

Where a Notice of Related Cases is filed suggesting that a petition for probation action and/or a violation of the terms of special release should be related to a new indictment, and the basis of the probation petition or alleged supervised released violation is the conduct underlying the new indictment, unless the original sentencing judge desires to retain the first case, the two cases shall be related and the judge assigned to the new criminal case shall also be assigned the earlier case.
