ORDER APPOINTING REFEREE IN BANK- ) GENERAL ORDER NO. 32  
RUPTCY AS SPECIAL MASTER )

When a Chapter X action is filed with the clerk of the court, the same will be referred by the court to the referee in bankruptcy in whose geographical area of responsibility the applicant is located and the said referee shall act as a special master for the judge to make a recommendation to the judge as to the acceptability of the plan and the appropriateness of any temporary restraining orders submitted in connection with said plan. The petitioner shall prepare a form of order for referral in the form attached hereto marked "Exhibit A." The recommendation of the referee to the judge concerning the feasibility of the plan and the appropriateness of the temporary restraining order shall be in writing and shall be processed by the referee as a priority item on his calendar in order that the court's order can be promptly filed.
