Amendment to General Order No.15

Rule 6 of the Bankruptcy Rules of the Eastern District of California as set forth in General Order No. 15, adopted by the Judges of this Court on September 19, 1966, and filed in the General Order Book of this Court on September 19, 1966, is amended to read as follows:


**RULE 6. STENOGRAPHIC RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS  
BEFORE REFEREE**

Each Referee may designate one or more official reporters, and all proceedings before him shall be recorded by shorthand, stenotype, or approved electronic recording device.

The compensation of the reporters shall be fixed by the Referees with a minimum of \$5.00 to be paid by each bankrupt. Any other compensation of the reporters shall be set by the Referees and charged against the assets of the estate, except that in adversary proceedings the compensation may be taxed as costs.
