Pursuant to direction from the Judicial Council of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals the following rules are adopted by this court for the prompt preparation of transcripts in criminal cases on appeal:

1. The preparation of transcripts for all criminal appeals shall take precedence over any other transcript that is pending or that is being worked on, i.e., civil appeals, court transcripts, depositions, etc.

2. Any criminal trial which has taken less than three days to try and is appealed shall be given priority over all other matters, and the transcripts covering same shall be completed and filed within 30 days from date of filing of notice of appeal.

3. No deposition or any type of transcript shall be worked on until all criminal appeals are
