GENERAL ORDER NO. 60

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C., section 631, et sequi, and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that Leonard A. Cosgrove is appointed a part-time United States Magistrate to serve the Central and Eastern Districts of California with duty station at Lancaster, California, at an annual salary of \$2,662.00. Said United States Magistrate shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m. on May 1, 1975, but, prior to the commencement of such duties shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C., sections 453 and 631(f).

The said part-time United States Magistrate is to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of four (4) years from the 1st day of May, 1975, unless sooner removed, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C., section 631(c).
