GENERAL ORDER NO. 89

In accordance with the authority conferred by TITLE VII OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964, § 354, it is

ORDERED that where a party to an action commenced under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. §§ 2000 et seq.) requests that the Court appoint counsel due to indigent status, or where such appointment is otherwise determined to be appropriate by the Court, the party shall be referred to the Community Legal Services Center of the McGeorge School of Law, and shall be screened for the purpose of determining and reporting to this Court as to their financial ability to retain private counsel.

In the event that the Community Legal Services Center of the McGeorge School of Law reports to the Court that a particular party is unable to afford private counsel, the report shall include a statement as to the willingness of the Community Legal Services Center of the McGeorge School of Law to accept appointment as counsel for the party.
