


IT IS ORDERED that the first paragraph of  
Section III C of the Federal Defender Plan is hereby  
amended to read as follows:


C. Management of Lists of Attorneys

The clerk of this Court shall maintain  
a current roster of all attorneys  
included on the panel approved by the  
Court with current office addresses and  
telephone numbers. On behalf of the  
Court, the Federal Public Defender shall  
manage and administer the Court approved  
panel of attorneys. The Federal Public  
Defender shall also maintain a public  
record of assignments of cases to the Public  
Defender, as well as assignments to private  
counsel, and current statistical data  
reflecting the proration of appointments  
as between staff attorneys of the Federal  
Defender Organization on the one hand,  
and private attorneys on the other,  
according to the formula described  
in Subtitle B of Title I of this Plan.




