- Ability to maximize system efficiency through individual performance profiles per volume/LUN capable of independent adjustment of compression, replication, and RAID types.
- Ability to maximize IOP performance with the use of dynamic SSD caching
- Ability to adjust IOPs and/or storage capacity per volume without requiring downtime.
- Ability to use thin provisioning to maximize available storage.
- Access to all management features from a secure web page interface.
- Ability to schedule block level snapshots which adjust to accommodate changed blocks only.
