

1. Civil law and motion calendar is heard on Mondays only at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom #2, Eighth floor. It is not necessary to clear a date prior to scheduling law and motion. The parties are required to comply with Local Rule 230, or other applicable rules and notice requirements.
2. If combined supporting papers or opposition papers exceed 25 pages, the parties are required to submit a complete set of all papers as a chambers courtesy copy, properly tabbed and fastened.
3. The Court requires Joint Pretrial statements. The statements must be filed seven days before the hearing date and e-mailed as a WordPerfect 8.0 or Word document to: awiorders@caed.uscourts.gov
4. All Criminal Cases will be heard on Mondays at 9:00 a.m. unless prior approval for a different time is given by the court. Any changes to the Monday law and motion calendar **MUST** be approved by the court no later than 12:00 Noon on the Thursday prior to the hearing.
6. All Criminal and Civil trials will begin on Tuesdays at 8:30am.
