**E-Mailing of Proposed Orders:**

As required by the rules, counsel shall submit via email to [kkorders@caed.uscourts.gov](mailto:kkorders@caed.uscourts.gov) the proposed order accompanying any application, request, stipulation or motion in Microsoft Word format. Pursuant to Local Rule 1-101, the document should include the attorneys' electronic signature(s) (i.e. /s/ First/Last name), as well as the date the document was signed.

**Page Limitations:**

Unless prior permission has been granted, memorandum of law and support of and in opposition to motions are limited to thirty (30) pages, and reply memorandum are limited to fifteen (15) pages. The parties are also cautioned against filing multiple briefs to circumvent this rule.
