ORDER APPOINTING REFEREES IN BANKRUPTCY AND THEIR CLERKS AND OTHER EMPLOYEES

GENERAL ORDER NO.\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_

WHEREAS, by Public Law 89-372, 89th Congress, S. 1666,
March 18, 1966, the Congress of the United States created the
Eastern District of California out of the Northern Division of
the Southern District of California and certain Counties of the
Northern Division of the Northern District of California, as said
Divisions existed prior to the effective date of said Act;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. With the exception of Conley Brown, each person serving as a Referee in Bankruptcy in and for the Northern Division of the Northern District of California immediately prior to the effective date of said Act, and each person serving as a Referee in and for the Northern Division of the Southern District of California immediately prior to the effective date of said Act, is hereby appointed as Referee in Bankruptcy for the Eastern District of California, with the same powers, duties and jurisdiction and at the same salary as existing immediately prior to the effective date of said Act; and
- 2. All Clerks, Reporters and other employees employed immediately prior to the effective date of said Act in the office of

each of said Referee in Bankruptcy appointed hereunder, are hereby appointed to the same respective positions for the above entitled Court with the same powers and duties and at the same respective grades and salaries with credit to be given in future promotions and step increases in salary for past services.

In the event individual appointments may be required, such appointments will be effective as of the effective date of said Act.
