WHEREAS, By Public Law 89-372, 89th Congress, S. 1666, March 18, 1966, the Congress of the United States created the Eastern District of California out of the previously existing Northern Division of the Southern District of California and a portion of the Northern Division of the Northern District of California;

Now, therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all banking associations heretofore designated as authorized depositories for Court funds in
the United States District Court, Southern District of California,
Northern Division, as it existed prior to the effective date of
said Act, and all banking associations heretofore designated as
authorized depositories for Court funds in the United States
District Court, Northern District of California, Northern Division,
as it existed prior to the effective date of said Act, are hereby
designated as authorized depositories for funds for this District
in accordance with all other terms of the original Orders
designating each such depository;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order will be effective upon each such depository filing with the Clerk of this Court a bond, entitled In the United States District Court, Eastern District of California.

Upon the approval and filing of each such bond, the Clerk and the Federal Reserve Bank are authorized to do and take all acts which may be appropriate or necessary to transfer the present security on each prior bond to such new bond.
