GENERAL ORDER NO. 202

Good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that Local Rule 461 is adopted as follows:

If the defendant or his counsel allege any factual inaccuracy in the presentence report, a written motion for correction of the report shall be served on the probation officer and the attorney for the government not later than five days prior to the date set for judgment and sentencing. The motion shall identify the specific statements alleged to be factually inaccurate; it shall set forth the specific remedy sought; and, it shall state the relevance of the matters contested to the sentencing or correctional treatment of the defendant.
