Certain matters having been called to the attention of the court concerning the security of the B. F. Sisk Federal Building and Courthouse, Fresno, California, the court enters its interim order as follows:

The United States Marshals Service is ordered to provide appropriate security to the grounds, building and occupants of the B. F. Sisk Federal Building and Courthouse in Fresno, California. In addition to continuing to insure against introduction of unauthorized firearms or other dangerous weapons into the United States Courthouse, the United States Marshals Service is further ordered to insure against the introduction of all electronic equipment, cameras, radios, telephones (including cellular), recording equipment, pagers, fax machines, copy machines or other mechanical equipment or similar devices,

including known or unknown materials that cannot be classified as safe or which are inappropriate to be introduced into the United States Courthouse, unless such devices or materials are previously authorized by the United States Marshals Service.
