Taking into consideration that Judge David F. Levi having previously served as the United States Attorney in this district is unable to receive such cases as may have been pending during his appointment, the Court finds the necessity to temporarily adjust the criminal case assignment procedure, pursuant to Appendix A (e) (2) of the Local Rules.


Therefore, the Clerk is hereby ordered to increase the number of case assignment "cards" for Judge Levi in the criminal case category of the Automated Case Assignment System in the Sacramento Division of the Eastern District of California so as to divide the criminal case assignments in compliance with 28 U.S.C. Section 137.

The Clerk is further ordered to make the necessary clerical adjustments upon receipt of notice that Judge Levi is unable to hear a particular criminal case, so that the sequence

of the Judge's names are random and secret, pursuant to the provisions of Appendix A (e) (3) of the Local Rules for the Eastern District of California.
