Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

Where a Notice of Related Cases is filed suggesting that a petition for probation action and/or violation of the terms of supervised release should be related to a new indictment, and the basis of the probation petition or alleged supervised release violation is the conduct underlying the new indictment, the two cases shall be related and the judge assigned to the new criminal case shall also be assigned the earlier case, unless the original sentencing judge desires to retain the first case, in which circumstance both cases shall be assigned to the original sentencing judge.
