The said part-time United States Magistrates are to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of four (4) years from the 1st day of May, 1975, unless sooner removed, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C., Section 631(c).

The Judges of this court are mindful of the fact that
Magistrate Richard E. Combs attained his 70th birthday on November 3,
1973, and that Magistrates Lewis E. Bronson, William R. Hulsy, Frank
C. Lerrigo, and Boyd Taylor will all reach their 70th birthday
during the term of office for which they are being appointed hereunder.
The Judges of this court nevertheless desire that notwithstanding
the present and impending ages of these persons, they shall serve
as part-time Magistrates for the terms of office herein designated.
This unanimous decision is made pursuant to and in compliance with
the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C. Section 631(d).
