GENERAL ORDER NO. 61

General Order No. 34 adopted by this Court April 30, 1971, is amended in the following particular:

PART ONE, III, 8 is amended to read as follows:

Original fixing of bail and motions for increase or reduction of bail, provided that no Magistrate shall increase or reduce any bail previously fixed by order of a Judge of this Court, other than upon the grand jury return, and no Magistrate shall hear any motion for reduction of a defendant's bail during or following his trial in this Court, provided however, that where a Judge of this Court has previously set bail on a Probation Violation Warrant, the Magistrate may reduce the bail fixed by the Judge upon order from or consent of the Judge, or upon stipulation of the Probation Officer of this Court or that Officer's Assistant or Deputy.
