ORDER APPOINTING
UNITED STATES MARSHAL

Public Law 89-372, 89th Congress, S. 1666, March 18, 1966, effective six months thereafter, having created the Eastern District of California, and having provided for a United States Marshal to be appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate; and

The Statute having become effective and the office of the United States Marshal being vacant;

IT IS ORDERED by the Court, pursuant to Section 545, Title 28, United States Code, that

ALLAN LINDLEY

be, and he is hereby, appointed United States Marshal for the Eastern District of California, to serve until the vacancy is filled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that

ALLAN LINDLEY

shall give bond in the sum of \$20,000, pursuant to Section 544, Title 28, United States Code.
