Cal. 1997). The actions involve 22 many of the same defendants and are based on the same or similar claims, the same 23 property transaction or event, similar questions of fact and the same questions of law 24 and would therefore entail a substantial duplication of labor if heard by different judges. 25 Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same judge is likely to effect a 26 substantial savings of judicial effort and is also likely to be convenient for the parties. The parties should be aware that relating the cases under Local Rule 123 merely 27

has the result that both actions are assigned to the same judge; no consolidation of the
