
1. Hon. Michael Bowman, Sacramento County Superior Court Judge, Chair

Consideration will be given to comments received from members of the bar and public, and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, legal ability, and commitment to equal justice under the law. All panel members have been advised in writing of the restriction on applying for a magistrate judge position for a period of one year after the conclusion of their service as set forth in §420.30.20(d) of the Regulations. The panel shall report to this Court within ninety (90) days whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment.
