
Good Cause Appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court transfer to the Clerk of the District Court all monies currently on deposit in the Bankruptcy Court's nonappropriated fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that henceforth whenever monetary sanctions are imposed for violation of the bankruptcy local rules and bankruptcy court orders not amounting to contempt, said monies shall be deposited directly to the nonappropriated fund of the District Court.

All funds derived from sanctions imposed by the Bankruptcy Judges of this Court shall be utilized in conformity with the "Plan for Administration of Nonappropriated Funds," General Order No. 154, adopted by the Judges of the District Court on April 10, 1984.


