


GENERAL ORDER 169


The bankruptcy judges may designate by order the clerk of the bankruptcy court to be the accountable officer for all monies paid into court, and to collect and account for all fees, costs and other monies collected, in petitions and proceedings pending before or adjudicated by a bankruptcy judge in this district.

Upon entry of an order by the bankruptcy judges designating the clerk of the bankruptcy court as accountable officer, no liability or accountability for such fees, costs or other monies shall accrue to the clerk of this court or any of his deputies. The effect of this order shall relate back to July 10, 1984, the day of enactment of the Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984.




