GENERAL ORDER NO. 30

Effective the 15th day of July, 1970, persons charged in Yosemite National Park with any petty offense (as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 1 - offenses punishable by a term not exceeding six months or a fine not exceeding \$500, or both) except those marked with an asterick hereinafter set forth in this Order may, in lieu of appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated for the offense, waive appearance before the United States Commissioner for Yosemite National Park, and consent to forfeiture of collateral. Persons charged with an offense marked with an asterick in the list hereinafter set forth, must appear before the United States Commissioner for Yosemite National Park. Except for the offenses hereinafter marked with an asterick, the offenses for which collateral may be posted and forfeited in lieu of appearance by the person charged, together with the amounts of collateral to be posted are:
